MindChamps grows to 10 centres in Australia, with 2 Australian medal recipients joining its global education team

Australia, 24 September 2018 – MindChamps PreSchool Limited (MindChamps) officially welcomes two new centres, located in Hurstville and Wheeler Heights, into the organisation's growing international network.

This brings the total number of early learning centres that MindChamps operates in Australia to 10, all strategically located in and around Sydney.
