What opportunities are there for an Australian Skin Clinics?

Australian Skin Clinics is experiencing significant growth due to client demand. We have new clinic and existing clinics available within Australia and New Zealand.

What investment is required?

The investment will depend on the size of the clinic and whether it is a new or existing location. We will work with you on your budget and location requirements.

Is now a good time to purchase an Australian Skin Clinics Franchise?

Absolutely. Australian Skin Clinics is widely recognised as an authority in our industry. In 2014 we were nominated as a National Finalist for the Franchise Council's Emerging Franchise Award and we were ranked at number 19 in the BRW Fast Starters 100 Award. Our franchise was formed at the end of 2011 (after 15 successful years trading as a solo clinic). We have had 60% growth in clinic locations over the last 12 months and are continually opening new locations to keep up with client demand. Some of the reasons that our franchises flourish even in difficult trading periods are: economies of scale, bulk purchase agreement, brand recognition, support, and proven effective systems.

Is there training available?

Once you are an approved Australian Skin Clinics Franchisee, training, coaching and ongoing support is all available to you from the Franchisor. You also gain access to the wealth of knowledge within the franchise network as well as access to online training and development and internal communication systems.

Will I be in charge of hiring staff?

Yes. As a Franchisee, you will have control of overseeing all hiring and management of staff within your clinic but will receive assistance where required from Master Franchise.
